

Rules & Regulations for Virtual Festival of Remembrance:

a. Dates of Contest: The contest will begin August 1, 2020 8AM – August 27th at 5PM CST. Void where prohibited. Odds of winning depend on the number of participants.

b. Entering: Raffle winners will be drawn the evening of August 28, 2020 at 6PM during our Live Facebook Celebration.

7. Taxes
